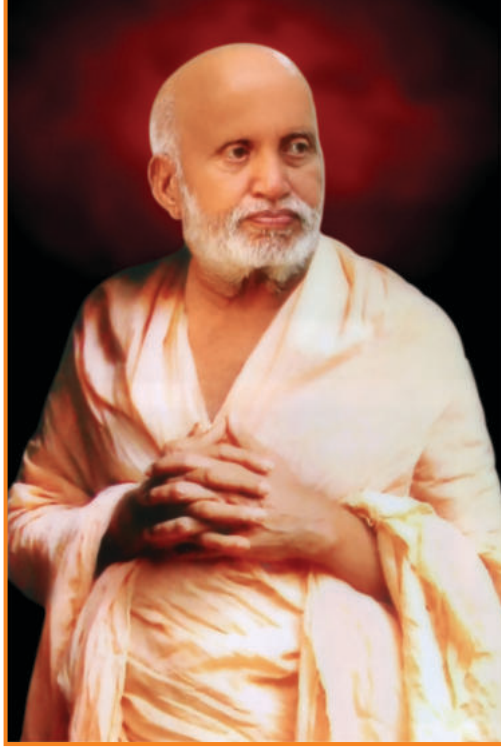

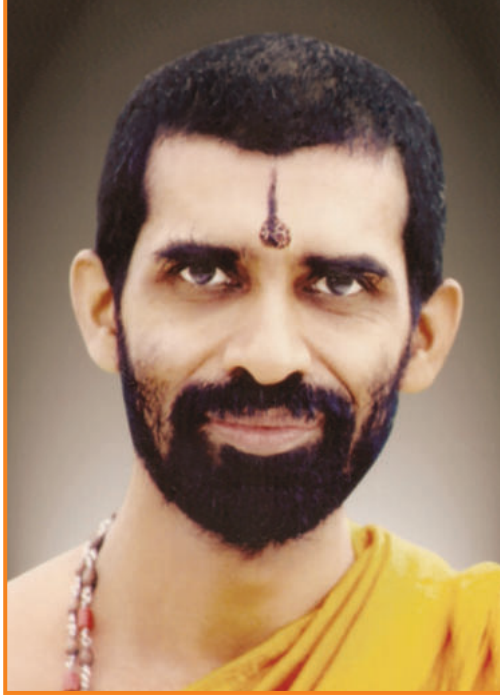

## **GENERAL RULES OF CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE**

1. The students should be polite and courteous, wherever they go. They should remember that the school is judged by their behaviour.
2. All students are expected to attend the school on the re-opening day after each vacation.
3. A student who absents himself/herself from class must explain the reason for the absence in the form of a letter from the parent or guardian.
4. No student should leave the school premises during working hours without the permission of the Principal. No student will be allowed to go out without a prior written note from the parent.
5. Parents or guardians are not allowed to meet their children/wards or meet the class teachers during the working hours. However, they can meet them for half an hour after the school hours.
6. Students are expected to address their teachers and all members of the staff with due respect and politeness. They must show gentleness and courtesy to their classmates. Refined manners, righteousness and self-restraint should distinguish every student of this Centre.
7. As an English Medium School, we encourage conversation in English in the school.
8. Any damage to the Centre's property must be repaired at the cost of the "offender class". Students responsible for repeated damage to the Centre's property are liable to be sent out of the Centre.
9. Irregular attendance, habitual idleness, disobedience and conduct injurious to the moral tone of the Centre are sufficient reasons for the dismissal of a student.

10. Every student is expected to attend the school, so as to have at least 75% of the number of working days during the academic year, failing which his/her promotion to the next class is liable to be withheld.
11. No collection of money is permitted in the school for any purpose except those authorized by the School Management.
12. Students of the Pre-Primary School will be allowed to stay in the school premises after the school hours till 12.25 p.m. Students of the Primary and High School should leave the premises by 3.30 p.m.
13. Accidental minor injuries to students during the working hours will be administered with First Aid. Parent/Guardian will be informed if the student requires further medical attention.
14. Parents / Guardians are requested to ensure that their children/wards do the assigned Home work regularly. Students who do not do their Home work and do not come to the Centre with required materials in time, shall be disciplined suitably by the Class Teachers and subject teachers. Habitual offenders in these matters are liable to be sent home. Parents / Guardians are requested to appreciate the necessity for all the students being subject to discipline of the Centre and not to interfere with the authorities in this regard. In case the Parent / Guardian is dissatisfied with such disciplinary action taken by the Centre, he / she is at liberty to withdraw the student from the Centre.
15. The Management reserves the right to expel any student for reason of habitual disturbances in the class and repeated disobedience of the instructions of the Teachers and the Principal.

16. Parents should follow the Rules, Regulations, Discipline, Procedures & Functioning of the school and see that they are strictly observed by their Ward.
17. The Management of the school is at liberty to cancel the admission, if any of the Rules and Regulations of the School are not followed and the decision of the Management shall be final.
18. Indecent behaviour by Parents / Guardians towards the School's Staff will be sufficient cause for the dismissal of the student.
19. Parents / Guardians are advised not to display their Profession, Official Position, Religion etc., by their Dress or Behaviour.
20. Prior permission must be obtained from the Principal, if children have to be taken out of station by parents / guardians which is not encouraged during regular working days of the school.
21. Parents are strongly discouraged from visiting the school staff at their residence. Giving any gifts to Staff on their Birthdays / Teachers' Day or any occasion is strictly prohibited.
22. Students are permitted to distribute only small toffees / chikkis to their classmates and teachers on their birthday.
23. Students are medically examined every year by qualified doctors and any abnormalities in the health of the student are reported to the Parents / Guardians for appropriate action.
24. No student is permitted to bring any electronic gadgets to the school. Costly articles or money should not be brought to Centre. Student should not wear costly ornaments or jewelry. In case of violation of this rule, the articles will be confiscated.

25. Students using unfair means during examination will face disciplinary action.
26. Change of address or phone numbers of the parents / guardians should be communicated immediately to the Principal / Office.
27. Students of Class VI and above are permitted to come to school on bicycle.
28. Parents / Guardians are requested not to send students with Measles, Mumps, Chickenpox and other infectious diseases to the School till they are free from such infection. When a Student is free from infection he / she should produce a medical certificate issued by a Registered Medical Practitioner stating specifically that the student is free from infection and his / her presence will not be injurious to the health of the other students in the Centre.
29. Updating school details and commenting on the school / staff / students on any social networking sites is not permissible
30. Any correspondence with the parents will be solely transacted using the MCB portal, the credentials of which will be issued to every student during admission to the school.



## **RULES OF ADMISSION AND WITHDRAWAL**

1. Students are admitted to different classes only by the Management.
2. At the time of admission, the parent or guardian must furnish a certificate giving satisfactory evidence of date of birth of the child.
3. The date of birth given at the time of admission cannot be changed.
4. Students seeking admission from outside Karnataka State from Standard II and higher classes of the Centre should get their Transfer Certificates counter signed by the Educational Officers of the Respective States who control those Schools in which the students were studying earlier. While countersigning the certificate, the Educational Officers should record an endorsement that the migration has been permitted. Otherwise such students will not be admitted to the centre. The Management reserves the right to specify the class to which they are to be admitted in the light of such qualifying test as prescribed.
5. Students seeking admission from State/CBSE/ICSE Syllabus to Std. VIII and higher classes in the Centre should get their transfer certificate counter signed by the Block Education Officer and also obtain a letter granting permission, from the DDPI.
6. Applications for admission for classes, other than the nursery class, will not be considered, unless accompanied by the latest Transfer Certificate and Progress Report from the School last attended.
7. When a proper application is received from the parent/guardian for a Transfer Certificate, it will be issued only after all the fees due has been paid.
8. The age required for admission to Nursery class for the academic year 2025-26 :- Children born between 01-06-2021 to 31-05-2022.

## TESTS AND EXAMINATIONS

1. Attendance is compulsory, for all the Unit Tests and Examinations held during the academic year.
2. In case of absence from tests and examinations, leave must be obtained in advance from the Principal. Such leave will be granted only under extraordinary circumstances and for genuine reasons. A medical certificate should follow in case such absence is due to illness. In case any student is absent for any examination, there is no provision for re-examination. His / her result will be decided based on the performance in earlier examination/tests.
3. Students will normally not be allowed to appear for the Final examinations unless their fees have been paid in full till that period.
4. Four tests and two Examinations will be conducted during the academic year.
5. Due weightage will be given to Internal Assessment. Internal Assessments will be made on the basis of Child's class work, maintenance of books, regularity in H.W. and C. W.
6. The Tests and Examinations conducted in the School is as per the Rules of Govt. of Karnataka.
7. Since promotion to the next higher class depends on the overall performance of the students throughout the academic year, it is essential that he / she takes all the tests and examinations and completes all assignments on time.
8. Results of the Annual Examination will be announced on 10th April.

9. Parents are requested to refer to the Prospectus and School Diary regularly. They must sign in the Progress Report issued at the end of each Test / Examination. It is obligatory for parents to sign the progress card within three days of its issue; Parents should personally collect Progress Report when intimated. For loss of the progress card and alterations in it, the student will be fined Rs. 30/-.
10. Parent-Teacher meetings are held regularly. Parents / guardian are requested to utilize this facility to discuss their children's / ward's progress with the teachers with a view to further improve their performance.
11. Continuous Comprehensive Evaluation of the students in the Higher Primary and High School is done as per the instructions of the department.
12. Internal assessment through CCE is reflected in the X Std. marks card.
  - a) Formative Assessment - FA1, FA2, FA3 & FA4 is conducted for 50 marks.  
(20 marks pen and paper +30 marks activities)
  - b) Summative Assessment - SA 1 & SA 2 are conducted for 100 marks (I Language) and 80 marks (Remaining subjects).

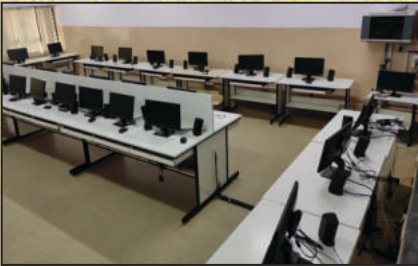
